#### #4 - Principal's Report

- Results from Middle Years Development Instrument (MDI) Survey Survey measures students health, wellbeing and assets. 201 students from grade 4 - 8 participated. Overall results were very positive for St. Luke students
- EQAO Results from spring 2022 Great results. St. Luke exceeded Board and Provincial levels in pretty much all categories.
- School Pictures Pegasus is the new vendor. They also have a Yearbook framework.
- Charitable works will do the Hat/Mitt/Sock drive again this year

#### #5 - Fundraising / Shrove Tuesday
